- ****ALL LAWN SPRINKLER SYSTEMS NEED TO BE TURNED OFF DURING SCHEDULED WORK. ROADWAYS MUST BE DRY. NO LANDSCAPING!****
- All cars need to be out of proposed work areas/courts/roadways by 7:00 AM until cones/barricades are removed. (Work will NOT commence until 8am, but we need to set up and mobilize our equipment). Cars that are not removed will be subject to towing at owner's expense.
- <u>*****Sealcoat is a liquid and needs up to 24 hours to dry</u> <u>*****Do not walk, run, or drive on wet sealcoat****</u>
- Once your court is done and you enter your court, be advised that tire marks may appear after Sealcoating. This is normal and they will eventually fade away.
- All, current day, work areas, will be clearly marked with Color Coded Yard Signs, along with directional arrows, showing which way to travel in and out of the community, using Ravens Crest Drive. Please pay attention to all Signage throughout community.
- Our Courtesy Golf cart will be available during work hours (8-4) to assist residents to and from their homes. Please call 732-264-7712 to make arrangements.
- If you have any questions, please see Supervisors wearing Yellow Vests.
- We will notify residents of any schedule changes with daily notices.
- When the final line striping is completed (next day after Sealcoating), Residents will be able to re-enter, once cones/barricades have been removed.
 For safety reasons, cones/barricades are NOT to be moved/removed by residents.
- Please proceed with caution when entering work areas, as there may be trip hazards. No Running, Playing, Biking, Children, or Pets on any work areas!
